Example paragraph: "To make significant progress in our understanding of the formation, evolution, and structure of extra-solar planetary systems, direct imaging of circumstellar environments is required. This will reveal the structure of protoplanetary and debris disks, the mass, radius, and composition of planets and their atmospheres and surfaces, and will eventually lead to the detection of Earth-like planets, which cannot be detected by the commonly used Doppler measurements. However, diffraction and scattering of the star's light by the telescope and turbulence in the Earth's atmosphere completely dominate the signal around the star where disks and exoplanets could be seen."
