Submit a proposal according to the following guidelines:

Nirvana Science Foreclosures (NSF) requests proposals from eligible scientists to initiate innovative research in all areas of science. Grants will be awarded to individuals for projects up to 5 years in duration and up to a total amount of €250'000. A panel of scientists from all areas of sciences will review and rank the received proposals. The Board of Directors will make the final selection, which will be announced around 16 November 2017.

Eligibility: Any BSc, MSc and PhD student or postdoc taking the Project Management for Scientists 2017 course at Leiden University.

Form: Single A4 page with at least 2 cm margins on all four sides, font no smaller than 11pt. The following sections are mandatory: Title, Contact Person with Address, Brief Biography of Principle Investigator, Summary, Project Description, Innovative Research Aspects, Project Plan and Budget. Only PDF files will be accepted.
